The festivities start at 12 p.m. on Main Street with the American Legion Post 451 gun salute at the Veterans Memorial Triangle. Sharon Iltis will kick off *Smokey Bear’s Protect Our Natural Resources* parade by leading the crowd in the singing of *America the Beautiful*. The parade will begin at the Veterans Memorial Triangle, continue down Main Street, and end at St. Anne’s Catholic Church. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place floats will be awarded Boulder Bucks certificates.

After the parade, head down Highway M to the Boulder Junction Volunteer Fire Department’s 19th Annual Chicken BBQ. This tasty BBQ will include ½ chicken, baked potato, roll, baked beans and dessert for just \$8.00 until 6:00 p.m. or sooner if sold out. And a little farther south, at the Boulder Junction Baseball Park on Highway M, Justy the Clown will host a variety of kids’ games, including a water balloon toss and relay races. Prizes will be awarded to top winners in various age groups. To add to the afternoon’s activities, Carnival treats will be available, along with music by Barb Boston. Baseball Park activities will end at approximately 3:00 p.m.
